



New Member Procedure

Crescent reviews completed applications for membership on an ongoing basis.

A person desiring membership in CSYC should download or print an application form from the homepage of crescentsail.com at the "Membership Application" link. When completed, please email the form to the Membership Chairman at joincsyc@gmail.com. Additional biographical data summarizing sailing experience is welcomed, but not required. The Membership Committee is also interested in skills or talents possessed by the applicant that may be useful to CSYC.

A completed application must include three letters of sponsorship from senior members to be considered. The sponsoring member shall deliver their letter of recommendation to the Membership Committee Chair as soon as possible.

Candidates may be asked to attend one or more informal meetings with the Membership Committee, Board of Directors, and Flag Officers.

Applicants are encouraged to attend the monthly general meetings at Crescent where they will be introduced. These are held at 8 PM on the first Tuesday of the month, September through June, excluding December (this meeting is restricted to members only).

New members will be voted in by the Board of Directors AFTER application, sponsor letters, checks, and completion of a 14 day posting.

Successful candidates' membership fee (initiation fee) and prorated dues are due with application. Checks, should be made payable to "Crescent Sail Yacht Club."

Successful candidates are asked to attend the next general meeting at which time they will be formally received into Crescent. At that meeting, you will receive an electronic copy of the constitution, regulations and procedures, and gate card.

Candidates are reminded that Crescent does not maintain a waiting list. Unsuccessful candidates may request to be reconsidered the following membership cycle without submitting a new application. Candidates who are twice unsuccessful must submit a new application if they still wish to be considered for membership.
