Sailing Highlights

Monday Night Doublehanded racing is in June and August around a six mile triangle course, starting and finishing at Crescent's breakwall. After sailing, share stories of sailing renown with fellow racers at the Tiki Hut potluck—burgers, brats, and more!



The CSYC small boat regatta is a mid-June Saturday event in the late afternoon, finishing in time for sunset, dinner, and awards.



Thistles, Flying Scots, Lightnings, and Catamarans race on Wednesday evenings and Sunday mornings. A casual get together on shore follows racing, with theme parties sponsored by each fleet throughout the summer.

The CSYC annual DRYA regatta is in late August: it is the largest DRYA regatta on Lake St. Clair, attracting over 90 entries. Dinner, awards, and socializing in the evening allow competitors to relax while recapping a beautiful day on the lake.
